Guy Porlier is a singer / actor active on the Quebec artistic scene for more than 12 years now. He has worked in several areas of the music scene and has been seen in several large-scale shows.

After holding one of the main roles in the Journal Musical "Danse Sing" for two years, he joined the Elvis Story troupe in the summer of 2001, just before going on American tour with the popular Boogie Wonder Band until the end of the year .

From 2002 to 2006, he spent most of his time performing for an international clientele aboard cruise ships. There was also the chance to present his first "One man show" which has also been a great success.

In July 2006 he decided to return to the mainland. It will not take long before the phone begins to ring. In November he hosted "La Soirée des Mérites Country", a reward for the country music industry in Quebec, at the Corona Theater. He then left for Atlantic City two months later to take a role in "The Best of Broadway". On his return, he was asked to play Charles Aznavour's repertoire at the Casino de Montréal in a show entitled "Salut à Bécaud and Aznavour ". He shared the stage with the most talented Manuel Tadros (in the role of Bécaud). He then left for Quebec City where he returned to the wonderful team of Elvis Story for the last summer of this Grand Spectacle in the old capital.

In September he is a member of the final selection jury and the Grand Gala Revelation at the St-Denis Theater in Montreal. He therefore returned to the teaching aspect of his profession, an aspect that he had put aside a little for the stage over the years.
